Zach Brown gave prayer. President Matt Henderson called to order the Council meeting.

Minutes from November 19th meeting minutes were reviewed. Motion to approve the minutes as written was made Chad Hager seconded by Jack Hinkle, and carried 7-0.

There was no Sheriff or Highway report presented.

Auditor Stroud presented the request from the Orange County Economic Development Partnership for board appointment. Rates remained the same as 2020. Motion to accept and approve the 2021 part time salary ordinance was made by Robin Stackhouse, seconded by Chad Hager, and carried 7-0. Stroud presented the 2021 Full Time and Elected Official Salary Ordinance. There was a \$500 stipend added instead of any raises for 2021. Motion to approve the 2021 Full Time Salary Ordinance was made by Alan Waynick, seconded by Chad Hager, and carried 7-0. Stroud presented the Council members with the annual conflict of interest forms for review and signing. In conclusion Stroud reported that the 1782 Notice was received for the County and the amounts were as published and operating balances were acceptable in the levy funds. Motion to approve the 1782 notice with no changes was made by Zach Brown, seconded by Chad Hager, and carried 7-0.
